## HAMPSHIRE POWER (ASHBY AGGREGATION)

Electric suppliers and distribution companies are required to provide customers with a disclosure label. The label enables customers to look at the energy sources, air emissions, and information about the supplier's company in order to make a more informed choice of a power supplier.

1. Electricity customers in New England are served by an integrated power grid, not particular generating units. The above information is based on the most recently available information for the NEPOOL Generation Information System. Hampshire Power procures all of its electricity supply through system power contracts from the system, not from specific generating units. Hampshire Power (Ashby Aggregation) began serving customers in Massachusetts in July 2015.
