COMMUNITY CHOICE POWER SUPPLY PROGRAM



The <u>Town of Carlisle</u> is announcing the new rates and term for its Community Choice Power Supply Program through its new electricity supplier, **Dynegy Energy Services**. The Town's new aggregation rates are fixed **for all rate classes for 24 months** as follows:

Program Product	Term	New Rate (Supply Only)	Renewable Energy Content
Standard (default)	January 2024 to January 2026	\$0.15989 per kWh	25% MA Class I RECs above minimum state requirements
Optional Basic	January 2024 to January 2026	\$0.15025 per kWh	Meets MA renewable energy requirements
Optional Green 100	January 2024 to January 2026	\$0.17896 per kWh	100% MA Class I RECs
Rates apply to service beginning and ending on the days of the month that your meter is read in your service area. This date varies by account 1			

For comparison purposes, Eversource's Residential Basic Service rate is fixed at \$0.17251 per kWh from January 1, 2024 through July 31, 2024*.

It is important to note that <u>no action will be required</u> by individual consumers. All accounts currently enrolled in the Town's Program will be switched to Dynegy as of the January 2024 meter reads. This change will be noted on the January 2024 bills and will be seen on the February 2024 bills. *Normally, the term would be through June 2024 but this is a transition term. In September, the Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities (DPU) issued an Order instructing Eversource to change its Basic Service periods to February through July and August through January [mass.gov/news/dpu-orders-schedule-changes-to-basic-service-rates]. This is expected to mitigate large seasonal changes in Basic Service electricity supply prices.

Basic Service rates change twice a year or more, depending on rate class. As a result, the aggregation rate may not always be lower than the Basic Service rate. The goal of the aggregation is to deliver savings over the life of the Program against Eversource Basic Service. However, such savings and future savings cannot be guaranteed.
