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LAWRENCE ENERGY CHOICE PROGRAM



The City of Lawrence is pleased to announce that **First Point Power** has been selected as the supplier for its Energy Choice Program. This Program is a municipal aggregation which enables local government to combine the purchasing power of its residents and businesses to provide them with an alternative electricity supply option (M.G.L. c. 164, § 134).

National Grid has identified your account as ineligible for automatic enrollment at program launch because you are: (1) receiving electricity from a third-party supplier or (2) enrolled in their GreenUp program. Residents and businesses in the City who are currently receiving electricity from National Grid Basic Service will be automatically enrolled unless they choose not to participate and OPT-OUT. **However, you will not be automatically enrolled given you have already made a choice other than National Grid Basic Service.**

The City's aggregation rate is fixed **for all rate classes for 30 months** as follows:

Term	Rate (Supply Only)	Renewable Energy Content
May 2025 to November 2027	\$0.13263 per kWh	Meets MA renewable energy requirements
<i>[Rate applies to service beginning and ending on the days of the month that your meter is read in your service area. This date varies by account.]</i>		

Everyone in the City is eligible to join this Program and may OPT-IN at any time. Some suppliers have a termination fee for leaving their contract early. **Please check with your current supplier and confirm that you will not incur an exit fee before enrolling in the City's Program.**

Basic Service rates change twice a year or more, depending on rate class. As a result, the aggregation rate may not always be lower than the Basic Service rate. The goal of the aggregation is to deliver savings over the life of the Program against National Grid Basic Service. However, future savings cannot be guaranteed.
