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ROCKPORT ANNOUNCES ENERGY PROGRAM START DATE
*Notifications mail in mid-October. Program will lower electricity costs and
offer environmental benefits.*

ROCKPORT, MA – The Town of Rockport is pleased to announce that it’s launching its Community Choice Power Supply Program this winter to provide an energy program that is stable, affordable and incorporates additional renewable energy. Rockport signed a thirty-five month contract with Dynegy Energy Services.

Beginning with the December 2025 meter reads, Rockport’s Program will offer two products with varying amounts of renewable energy content. “We’re pleased to launch this energy program that not only helps residents save money, but also provides access to renewable energy with the added benefit of stable rates,” said Paul Murphy, Rockport Select Board Chair.

*National Grid’s Residential Basic Service meets MA renewable energy requirements and is in effect from August 1, 2025 through January 31, 2026. Assuming usage of 600-kilowatt hours of electricity per month, residents can expect to see an average savings for that period.

The Rockport Community Choice Power Supply Program is a municipal aggregation program which, according to Massachusetts law (M.G.L. c. 164, § 134), enables local government to combine the purchasing power of its residents and businesses so that it can provide them with an alternative electricity supply. Approximately 215 Massachusetts communities, to date, have chosen to develop community choice electricity programs to benefit their residents and small business owners.

Residents will not notice any change in their electricity service. The only discernible difference will be that Dynegy will be printed under “Supply Services” on National Grid’s monthly bills starting in January 2026. Residents and small business owners will continue to receive one bill from National Grid and to send payments to National Grid for processing. There will be no interruption in billing, power, or customer service.

No action is required by ratepayers to participate in this cost-saving program. The Program will be operated on an opt-out basis, meaning that all Rockport residential and business customers currently on National Grid’s Basic Service will be automatically enrolled into the Program unless they choose to opt-out.

There are no enrollment, early termination, or cancellation fees attached to the Rockport electricity program. Residents who choose to opt-out can also opt-in at a later date if they so choose at no cost. However, anyone switching from a contract with a third-party supplier may be subject to penalties or early termination fees charged by that supplier. Ratepayers should verify terms before switching.

Basic Service rates change twice a year or more, depending on rate class. As a result, the aggregation rate may not always be lower than the Basic Service rate. The goal of the aggregation is to deliver savings over the life of the program against National Grid’s Basic Service. However, future savings cannot be guaranteed.

Residents or business owners with a supplier block on their account must contact National Grid to request that the block be removed if they want to participate in Rockport’s electricity program.
