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## THE TOWN OF BILLERICA'S COMMUNITY CHOICE POWER SUPPLY PROGRAM



The Town of Billerica is announcing the new rates and term for its Community Choice Power Supply Program through its current electricity supplier, **Dynegy Energy Services**. The Town's new aggregation rates are fixed **for all rate classes for 34 months (January 2026 to November 2028)** as follows:

For comparison purposes, National Grid's Basic Service rates are fixed from August 1, 2025 through January 31, 2026 -- Residential at \$0.15484 per kWh and Commercial at \$0.14411 per kWh. National Grid's Basic Service rates will change on February 1, 2026.

**No action is required** by individual consumers. All accounts currently enrolled in the Town's Program will continue to see Dynegy printed under the "Supply Services" section of their monthly bill.
